DR. GERD HEUSCHMANN

German rider and equine veterinarian Dr. Gerd Heuschmann is well-known for his plain speaking regarding the incorrect and damaging training methods commonly employed by riders and trainers involved in competition today. He actively supports the FEI's motion against "hyperflexion" (also known as Rollkur) being used as a training aid in today's performance horses. His lectures explain in depth the physical effects of such training on the horses' anatomy and physiology.



DR. DEREK HALEY

Having joined the Ontario Veterinary College at the University of Guelph in 2009, Dr Haley leads a research program in applied ethology and animal welfare. The goal of his research program is to improve understanding and appreciation of the behavioural biology of animals, which should ultimately improve animal health and productivity and enhance our appreciation of animal behaviour studies as a useful tool for investigating questions about the quality of life that animals experience.

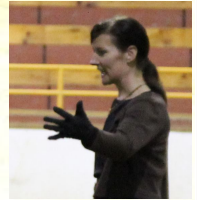
