English:

Boots-tall or paddock (with ½ chaps)

Breeches (no jeans or sweat pants)

Riding gloves

Approved Hard Hat with attached harness properly fastened

Long or short sleeved shirt/blouse

Western:

Boots

Jeans

Hard Hat with attached harness

Long or short sleeve shirt/ blouse

IMPORTANT NOTICE:

Approved riding helmets with the chin strap properly fastened must be worn by all students riding on University of Guelph: Kemptville Campus property.

ALL students entering the horse barns or arenas, or working around horses must wear appropriate footwear: boots not made of canvas or cloth, closed toed and closed heeled, a clear heel between ½" – 1 ½" with a non-slip sole. Steel toed boots, running shoes, sandals and crocs are not acceptable due to safety concerns. Acceptable types of boots include paddock boots, rubber boots, hiking boots, work boots (non steel-toed) or riding boots.

Please ensure participant arrives with all necessary safety equipment and attire.
