### Program Description

- Learn the practical skills required to succeed in the landscape horticulture industry.
- Improve your business, managerial and entrepreneurial skills.
- Acquire the science background of plant production (plant science, soil science, plant identification, plant propagation), a grounding in business practices (accounting, business management, human resource management), the practical skills (landscape construction I & II, landscape design, nursery management) and more.
- Fulfill the requirements for both the Horticulture Diploma and the two levels of in-school training for the Horticulture Technician Apprenticeship.

### Entrance Requirements

- OSSD or equivalent with a minimum 60%.
- Apply through [ontariocolleges.ca](http://ontariocolleges.ca) (K406)
- **Apply early! Applications are accepted on a first come basis.**

### Career Options

- Design, install, maintain residential and commercial landscapes.
- Nursery/Greenhouse production, sales and management.
- Turf and golf course management.
- Plant protection and pest management.

### Features

- Eligible for OSAP.
- Successful applicants will have no additional charges for apprenticeship registration with MTCU.
- On-site meals and residence available (limited space).
- Summer placement assistance provided.

### Program Length

- 4 semesters and a summer work terms.

### Start Date

- September 2009


