- The Second Career Strategy is for recently laid-off unemployed workers for whom long-term skills-training is the most positive thing to help people get back into the local job market.
- Recently laid-off unemployed workers can be active EI claimants, EI Reachback or non-Eligible. (Reachback means to have been on EI for the last 36 months)
- Talk to an EI counselor to apply for the Second Career Strategy.
